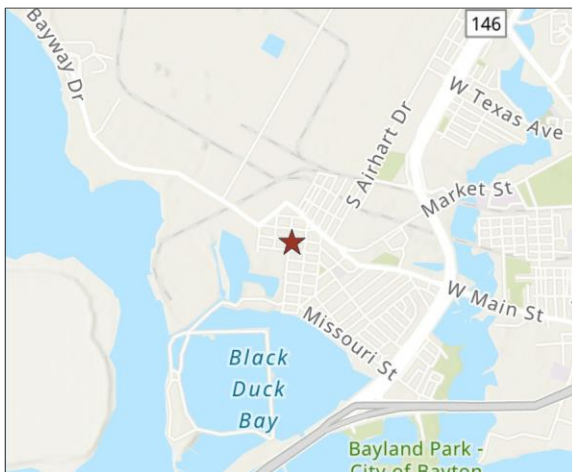
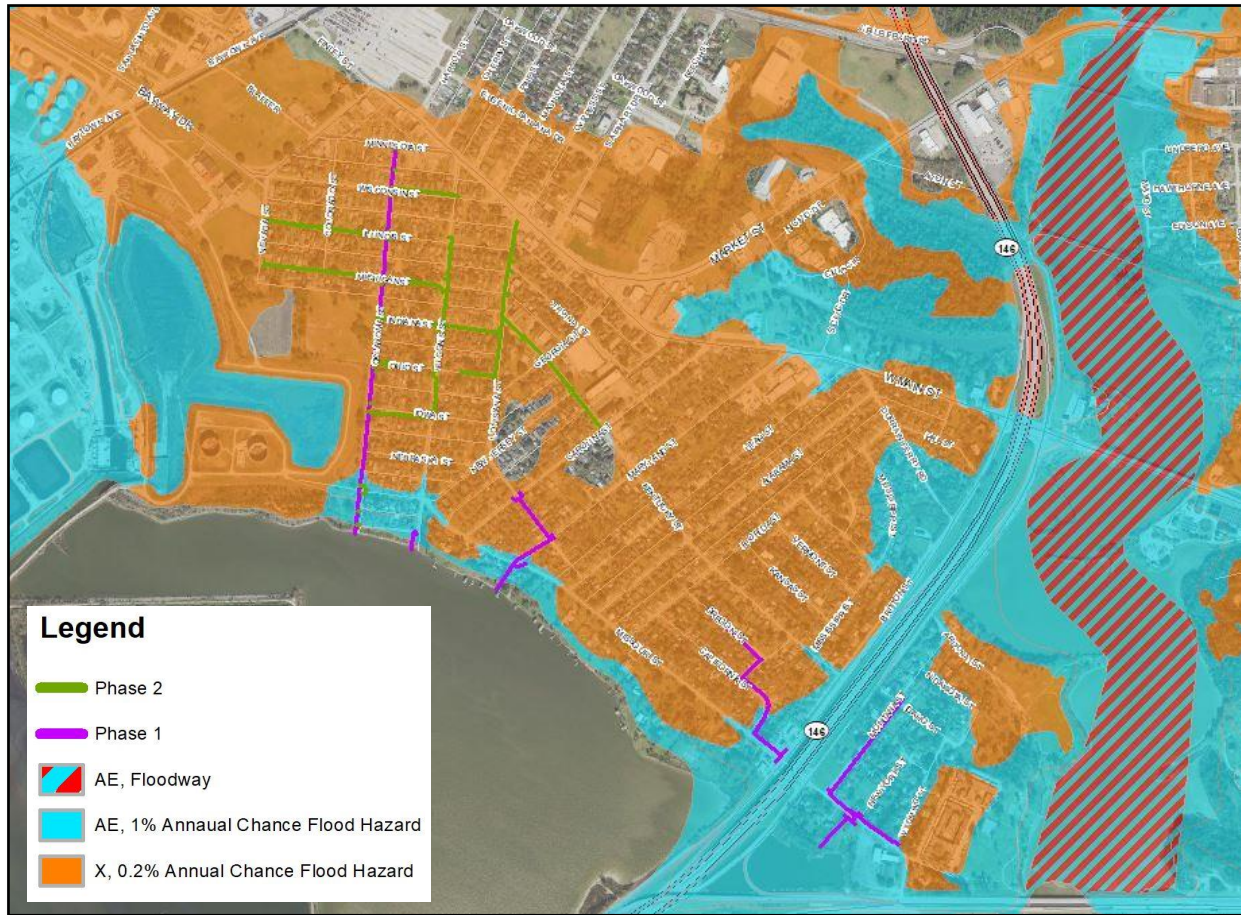




West Baytown Drainage Improvements Phases 2 and 3



Location:

Various streets between Market Street and Iowa Street.

Description:

Enlarge the remaining storm sewer systems throughout the neighborhood to handle more water and reduce road flooding during heavy rain events. The systems will tie into the new trunkline along Oklahoma Street. Project will also include replacement of pavement, sidewalks, and utilities within the street corridor.

Benefits:

Project will improve the system capacity from a 2-year storm event to a 5-year storm event.

Additional Information

This project was listed as a high need in the 2021 Stormwater Master Plan. Due to the high cost of the project, it was broken into phases. Phase 1 was funded in partnership with Harris County. Phase 1 includes the main trunkline along Oklahoma St. to carry stormwater from the smaller stormwater pipes and inlets to the bay. It is designed and ready for construction. Phase 2 and 3 includes the smaller stormwater pipes and inlets that feed into the trunkline. Phases 2 and 3 have not started design and are not funded for design. The project includes sidewalk repair, driveway replacement, pavement replacement, water line, and sanitary sewer lines. Phases 1-3 will address the entire neighborhood drainage improvements.
